- The Only Race of its Kind in the US
- Participants From as Far as Las Vegas
- Attendance Estimates:
2012 – 2500-3000, in 2013 – 5000-6000
- During the Event, ALL the Bars are Full, the Restaurants are Flooded Afterwards, the Deli “Ran out of Everything!”
