






UickStart Mini-grants

- \$1,000 grants for near-term SRTS activities that:
 - Encourage safe walking, bicycling, and driving habits
 - Increase the number of students walking and bicycling to school



Map showing schools that have received QuickStart Minigrants. Over 110 QuickStart Minigrants have been awarded so far.






