## BALTIMORE BIKE SHARE WHY BIKE SHARE IN BALTIMORE?

- Successful new transportation application that plays to Baltimore's density which translates into short trips and public transit
- Extends the reach of alternative transportation
- Puts Baltimore in position to adopt best features of other cities' programs to deliver great bike-share system





## BALTIMORE BIKE SHARE WHY BIKE SHARE IN BALTIMORE?

- Zipcar on Bikes!
- Swipe, ride, drop
- Last mile transit
- 50% increase in bicycle usage in recent years
- Leverage the City's 100 miles of bikeways





- Incorporate into City's Biking Plan
- Local bike economy boom

## BALTIMORE BIKE SHARE STRATEGIC PLAN

#### PHASE I

- 25 Hub Locations
- 475 Docking Racks
- 250 Bicycles
- Continue Baltimore Cycle Track, bike trails, and bike lanes
- PHASE II
  - Title Sponsor Identified
  - 25 Additional Hub Locations Bringing Total to 50
  - 900 Docking Racks
  - 500 Bicycles





## BIKE SHARE IN BALTIMORE PHASE I MAP




