Annapolis!

Annapolis is a wonderfully walkable City. If you come to Annapolis during the legislative session, your best bet is to park in a garage and get around either on foot (most locations are less than a five-minute walk), take a scooter or e-bike, or use the FREE downtown Magenta shuttle, which services the garages along West Street and off Main Street.

Nearly all street parking in Annapolis is paid with time limits. In addition, it can be difficult to find street parking, especially during busy hours when parking spaces are as coveted as those gorgeous views from City Dock.

If you find a space you *think* might be free, keep an eye out for signs that indicate whether the spot requires a residential parking permit (RPP).

Please note that visits to the Maryland General Assembly for legislative business can take hours. You don't want to have to rush back to feed the meter just when your bill is being called.

HANDICAP PARKING:

Handicap parking spaces are available in all garages. There are a few handicap spaces available in commercial areas (handicap placards get double the amount of time posted). The FREE magenta shuttle is handicap accessible for those who park at downtown garages.

MORE PARKING DETAILS

WHAT IS RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT/RPP?



Parking spaces marked with "Residential Parking Permit Only" should not be parked in unless you are using a vehicle

with a registered Resident Parking Permit (RPP).

BIRD SCOOTERS AND E-BIKES



One of the great things about Annapolis is the fact that the City is bicycle- and scooter-friendly. Annapolis has entered into an agreement with BIRD for the

deployment of scooters and ebikes to help folks easily move around the City without a car. There are some places that BIRD scooters and e-bikes won't work. The no ride/no park zones in downtown include the area immediately around the Maryland General Assembly offices, the perimeter around the Maryland State House, and on the campuses of the U.S. Naval Academy and St. John's College.

FINES AND PENALTIES:




Tickets for violating parking rules will cost you (for example): \$50 for an expired or unpaid meter; \$500 for blocking a fire hydrant; \$500 for parking in a disabled spot

without a placard; \$100 for parking in a "no parking" zone and \$300 for parking at a redlined curb/blocking a bus stop or blocking a crosswalk. Fines are due within 10 days of issuance.

Free Magenta Shuttle

The FREE downtown Magenta runs in a continuous loop and operates Mon-Thur 6 am until 11 pm, Fri 6 am until midnight, Sat 8 am until midnight and Sun 8 am until 8 pm. Scan the QR code for the live shuttle tracker.





IS THERE FREE STREET PARKING IN DOWNTOWN ANNAPOLIS?

Most of downtown street parking is paid, either through metered/kiosks on the street, residential permit parking, or pay-by-phone. On-street residential paid parking is through the ParkMobile app (around \$4/hour) with a two-hour limit.

WHAT IS PAY-BY-PHONE?



The parking kiosks and signs say "pay by phone." What does that mean? The ParkMobile parking app (or website) allows you to use your smartphone to pay for

parking. All you need is your license plate and a credit card. The app can confirm your location before you pay, or you can use the unique four-digit code printed on the kiosk.

BEST BET FOR PARKING:



Park at a downtown garage and pay hourly, daily (or monthly).
